#### Dear Julia,

I am pleased to inform you that you have been admitted to the iteachTEXAS alternative certification

program. At this time, you have also been given access to instructNET, the instructional platform.

Once your personal payment plan information has been submitted, you have completed 150 hours, TEPC 5100 – 5300, of coursework, completed 30 hours of classroom observation, and passed a content test(s) (including associated test such as the Science of Teaching Reading), you will be given access to the Statement of Eligibility (SOE) for Internship form, which can be copied. On this form are listed all of the content areas, currently identified, in which a district may hire you to teach and in which you are eligible for initial certification. If you elected to take and pass additional content area TExES certification tests, you are eligible for hire in those content areas as well. As you attend job fairs, send in applications and go through the interview process, the SOE form provides proof to hiring school districts that you are enrolled in an alternative certification program as required by the Education Agency (TEA). In addition, your passing test results identify hirable content areas to school districts.

Once you successfully complete an instructional course, you will be moved on to the next course at midnight of the completion date.

Additionally, please visit the secure side of the website, instructNET, frequently to be aware of deadlines and program updates. You will be responsible for all information posted in instructNET. You are also required to update your personal information in instructNET.

Upon obtaining a teaching position, ask the school district's personnel office to complete the district portion of the Statement of Eligibility (SOE). Please have the district fax the completed form to the iteachTEXAS office. Once received in our office, you will be enrolled in the Residency course, you Are Hired, where you will obtain instructions for applying for your probationary certificate. If you are not contacted by a Field Supervisor within two weeks of starting your teaching assignment please contact the iteachTEXAS office.

Finally, if any school district would like to know more about our program, please provide them with our contact information. We welcome the opportunity to discuss the details of our program. Welcome to the iteach program and best wishes as you travel *The Road to Certification*.
